

St. Pius X Scrip Program

Rules and Guidelines

- 1) Orders must be turned in by 9:00 am on Wednesday each week and will be ready for pick up on the following Tuesday. Please designate from the choices on the order form where you wish to pick up your order.
- 2) Profits from Scrip sales will be split with 60% going to the tuition account of the purchasing family and 40% going to the St. Pius X Home School Council.
- 3) Each family will be using their telephone number as their account number. This number must appear on all orders you submit to ensure that they are recorded accurately.
- 4) All orders must be accompanied by a check made payable to “St. Pius X Spirit” or cash. Scrip payments are not tax deductible because you receive dollar for dollar value.
- 5) If your check is returned because of non-sufficient funds, you will be charged a \$25.00 fee.
- 6) Parishioners, family, friends and co-workers of our school families are welcome to purchase Scrip. They may designate that the profit from their purchases go to a particular school family’s tuition account. If some one does not have a specific family in mind to donate their profit to, they may choose to give the profit from their purchases to the St. Pius X Adopt-A-Child Program or to the St. Pius X Home School Council.
- 7) Scrip certificates are not returnable.
- 8) When you pick up your Scrip order, please open it and check it for accuracy. Your signature on the receipt indicates you have received your order in its entirety. If you have a problem, please contact Theresa Kennedy or Amy Storms immediately at (810) 235-8572.
- 9) Scrip certificates are the same as cash and should be handled accordingly. St. Pius X School will not be responsible for certificates that are lost, stolen or misplaced.
- 10) You must sign a waiver of responsibility before certificates will be released with your child. St. Pius X School accepts no responsibility for certificates delivered in this manner.

Profit Procedure

Profits will be issued twice a year:

1. In January (for the previous July-December earnings). This will be applied to the next tuition payment.
2. In July (for the previous January-June earnings). This will be applied to the following school year beginning balance.

Scrip profits can not be used for any SMART Tuition late fees.

Scrip profit must accumulate to at least \$20 for a tuition credit to the SMART Tuition Program.

Any amount less than \$20, parents of eighth grade students, and anyone who prepays their tuition account can choose from the following options:

1. Hold the money over for the next issue date
2. Donate it to the Home School Council
3. Donate it to the Adopt-A-Child Program
4. Choose Scrip certificates for the amount earned to the nearest \$5.

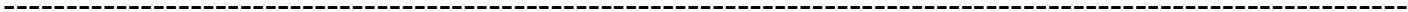

Meijer

Profit earned from the Meijer Program is treated the same as Scrip profit. It will be shared by the Home School Council (40%) and the participating family (60%). The profit for each family will be added to any profit earned from the Scrip program and will be credited to the tuition account according to the schedule above.
